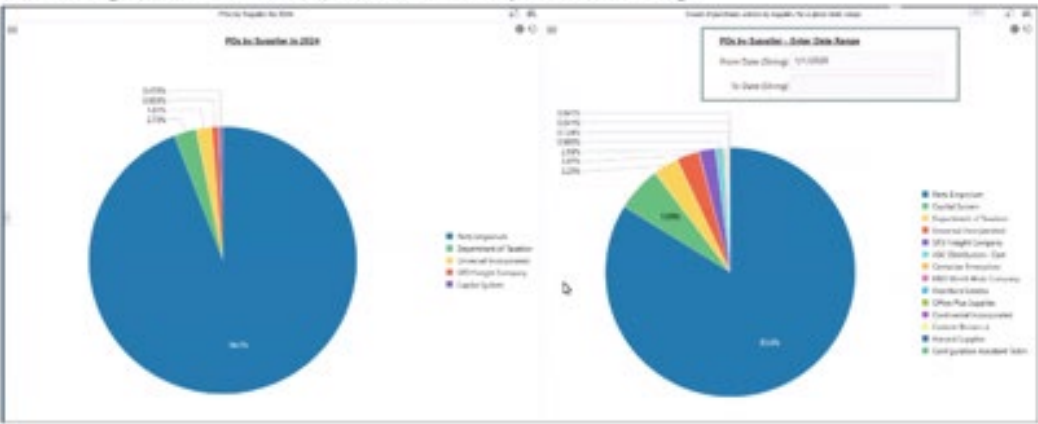

- Current Email Servers (Microsoft Exchange 365) REQUIRE Authentication User & Password
- Microsoft Deprecated Basic Authentication & Now Requires OAuth 2.0 to M365 Services
- Password Requires TLS/SSL Support
- Security Vulnerabilities if do not Supporting Latest TLS
- Currently Customers Forced to Provide Legacy SMTP Server to Support Just JD Edwards

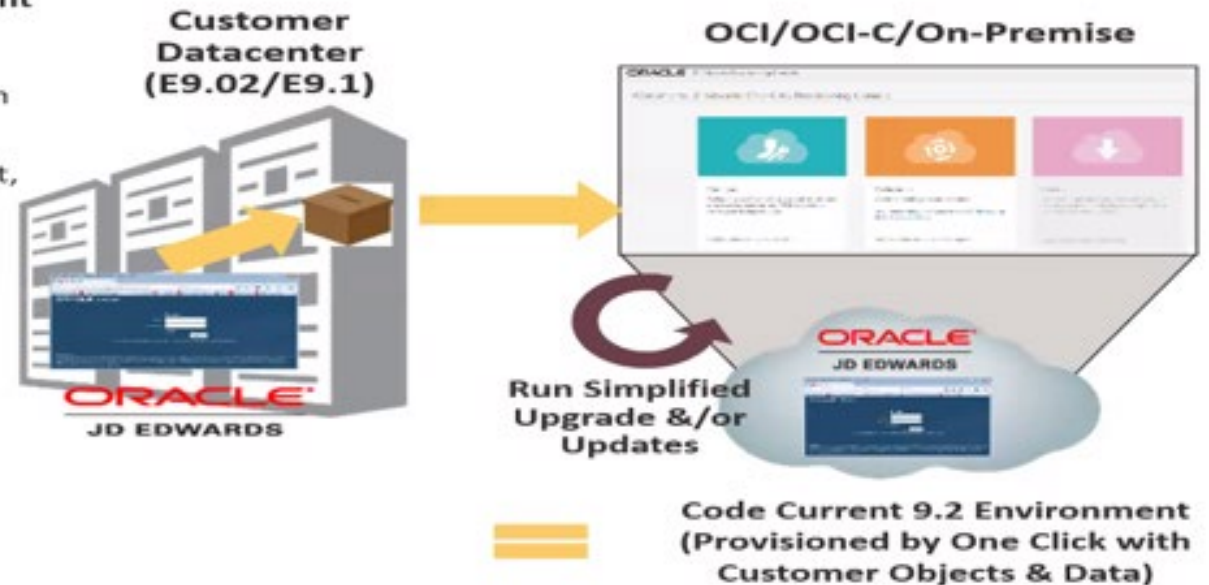

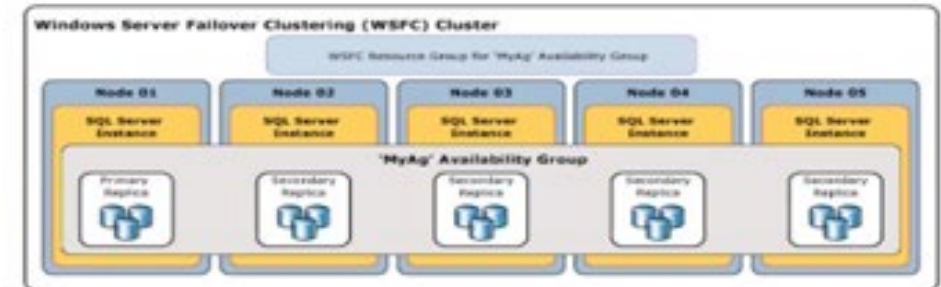

Increased Length of Media Object URLs

Business Problem:

- Currently Media Object URLs are limited to 254 chars
- Customers want to store URLs longer than 254 chars to utilize extended URLs and attach them as Media Objects in JDE for modern applications, APIs, and cloud services without any limitation,
- accommodate evolving business needs and ensure compatibility with longer URLs, reducing the need for frequent system updates

Value:

- Customers using external file storage such as OCI Object storage, Microsoft SharePoint etc. for storing and managing their media objects can now store the long URLs of the Media Objects in the Media Object URL type attachment.
- Allows seamless access to the Media Objects stored in external file storage.

Key Capabilities:

- Increase the permitted size of media object URLs to support more than 256 chars to 1000 chars
- Validate functionality with small and long urls to ensure continuity in functionality

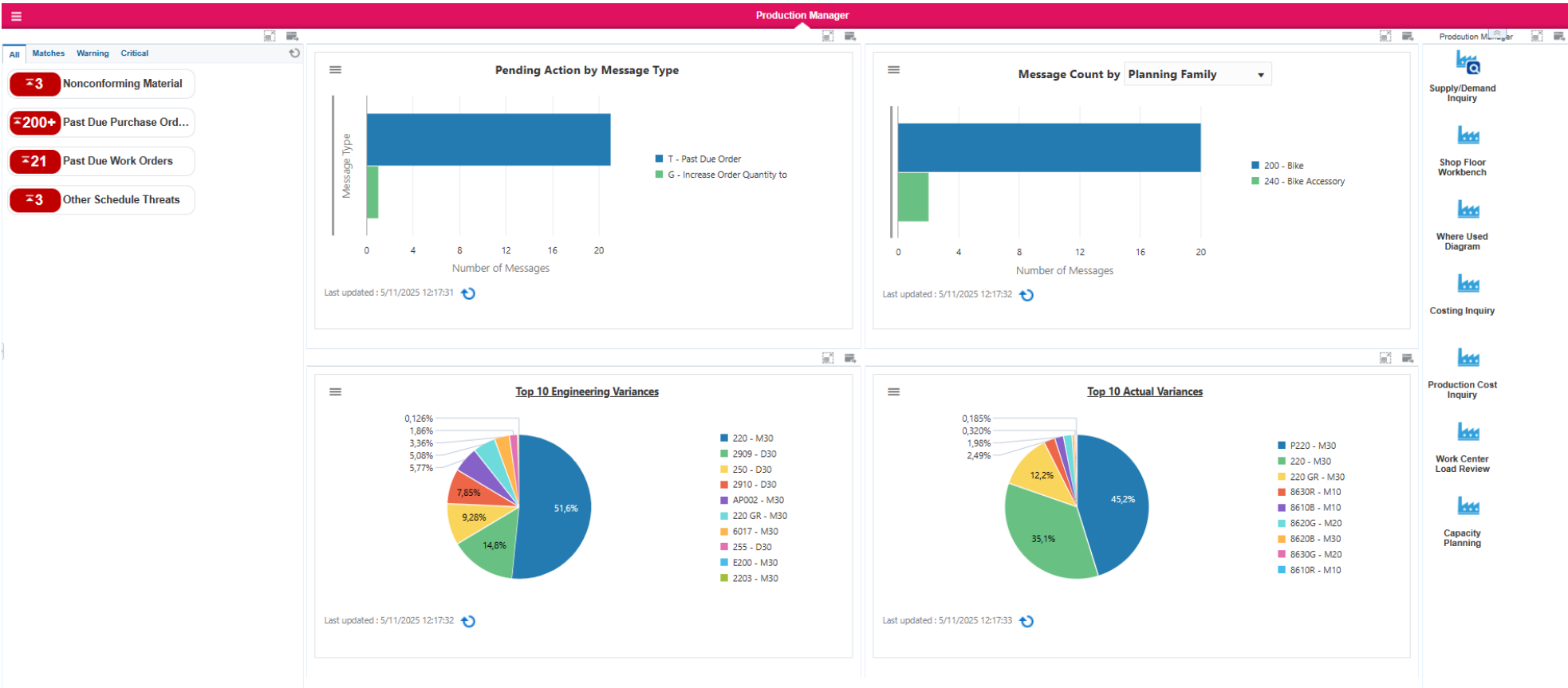
